### **College Uniform Policy**

#### **Rationale:**

The dress code of Assumption College Warwick requires a high standard of personal grooming together with an expectation that the correct uniform is worn appropriately at school and beyond the school gates. This is necessary for Assumption College to conform to the Workplace Health and Safety guidelines, which includes Sunsafe Policy, set out for all workplaces in Queensland.

#### Values:

In exercising our duty of care through Workplace Health and Safety, including Sunsafe Legislation, the staff and parents of Assumption College students will be diligent in helping students to be consistent with the current uniform policy and its consequences. The dress code instils in the students a pride, dignity and respect for themselves and their school. This policy seeks to, through the wearing of a set uniform:

- Create for the students a sense of belonging to the school community
- Provide circumstance to allow equality for all
- Allow students to bear witness to the values of Assumption College.

#### **Policy Statement:**

As members of a Catholic College dedicated to the preservation of the health and well-being of everyone in our community, we uphold the need to implement appropriate procedures and to practise behaviours which will help to prevent or minimise skin damage through over-exposure to the sun.

Furthermore, we value the safety of students beyond their years at our College.

#### **Consequences:**

All students are required to wear the correct uniform as per the school uniform requirements and present themselves well. It is expected that if the uniform is non-compliant a note of explanation is to be presented to the Pastoral Care teacher in the morning, signed by the parent. This note is required each day the uniform is non-compliant. Students will be required to hand over items which are non-compliant with the uniform policy. If a student receives three uniform infringements, they will be required to attend a lunchtime detention. Further non-compliance will result in further sanctions. Items that are not part of the College uniform can be confiscated and will be returned to the student at the end of the term. The College cannot accept responsibility for loss ordamage of these prohibited items, therefore we recommend that they not be worn. If the uniform non-compliance cannot be resolved at the College, consequences may include behaviour sanctions until the issue can be resolved.

The final interpretation of details of this uniform policy will be at the discretion of the Principal or a representative of the Principal.

#### **Senior Jersey:**

The senior jersey is an optional uniform item for Year 12 students. The senior jersey can be worn with the Summer and Winter formal uniform but should not be worn under the College blazer to and from school or at formal College occasions such as assemblies and masses, etc.

#### Hats:

The College shade hat must be worn at both morning, recess and lunchtime, the times of peak U.V. radiation. As well, students involved in activities outdoors during school time and at sports training after school must wear the College hat. This includes Health & Physical Education classes. All hats are embroidered with the student's name. Please note surnames will be used for embroidering. Initials will be added for students with the same surnames. Hats must be kept in good condition. Hats should be stored in the student's locker.

The College Uniform is available online from School Locker or at Danny Lyons, Warwick. The College hat must be purchased from the front office and will then be embroidered with the student's name.

#### **Guidelines:**

The full correct College uniform is to be worn on all school occasions. Students are required when wearing the school uniform out of hours to wear either all or none of the uniform and to wear the uniform as outlined in the policy. There can be no additions that are not listed below or exempted with Principal approval. Students ought to present themselves at all times in a neat, tidy and acceptable manner. Students' general appearance should reflect the respect they have for themselves and the College. Boys should wear shirts 'tucked' in. Socks should be pulled up and shoes polished at all times. Students are to wear white, or skin coloured under garments only.
